## Requirements: A Spot of TEAL quilt show

- Quilt must clean and in good condition, with no tears or stains.
- All quilts competing must be at least 48" x 48."
- No "cheater's cloth" quilts, panels, store bought or factory made quilts will be accepted.
- All quilts *must* contain a 4" wide sleeve sewn or securely pinned onto the top back edge of the quilt,
   1/4" from the top. Quilts without a sleeve will not be accepted.
- An identification label must be sewn on the back left corner of each quilt. A muslin cover will be pinned over the label during judging. Identification label must include: name and size of quilt, name of maker, name of quilter if different than maker, town where maker lives.
- Quilts must be submitted in a cloth bag or pillowcase, and must be labeled same as quilt (see above).
- Each quilt has a story, just like each of us. If you would like to include a story regarding your quilt, please do so on a 5X8 index card, type or print legibly in 50 words or less, and pin it securely to the lower left corner of the front of your quilt.
- Quilters wishing to sell quilts on display must make arrangements outside of the library.
- Quilt drop off *no later* than September 6, 2019, by appointment only.
- All quilts must remain on display for the duration of the show.
- Quilts must be picked up on Monday, September 23.

## **Category Descriptions**

A Spot of TEAL – quilt must contain *at least* one square inch of the color Teal. Entire quilt does not have to be totally teal color, only one square inch within the quilt.

**Novice** – A novice quilter must not have finished more than three (3) quilts, and be actively quilting less than three (3) years, and not have won a juried show.

**Group Quilt** – made by 2 or more people

**Memory Quilt** – To commemorate a special occasion, special person, special anything. Include a short note as to the specifics the quilt memorializes. May use t-shirts, ties, ribbons and bows, etc.

Quilter's Choice – For your quilts that don't fit into other categories.

**TEAL Challenge** – We call this the TEAL challenge because we are asking you to donate a quilt. Each quilt in the TEAL challenge category will be made available for our silent auction. The winning quilt in this category will be given to an ovarian cancer warrior. The challenge quilt must be no larger than 54" x 54." A Challenge quilt must contain at least a spot of the color teal. Criteria for all categories apply to the challenge quilt except the size.
